DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Friday, August 21 – Your Journey Begins

Your exciting journey begins as you board your overnight flight to Glasgow.

Day 2: Saturday, August 22 – Welcome to Glasgow

We meet our Travel Director and Driver at the Airport. From there we start with a Glasgow Walking Tour. Gain a fresh perspective on Glasgow as you explore the city through the eyes of a local expert guide, known as a 'weegie,' who will bring their own stories and perspectives. During the tour, you will not only visit the prominent landmarks of the city center but also gain an authentic glimpse into contemporary life in Glasgow. From historic cathedrals to vibrant street art, from poignant historical sites to esteemed universities, there is something to pique the interest of every visitor on this immersive experience. Please note that this tour is around 3 miles long (2.5-3 hours). It does incorporate a break.

Day 3: Sunday, August 23 – Stirling Castle

After breakfast we will head to Stirling Castle. Standing proud on the foreboding Castle Hill, Stirling Castle was once an important strategic stronghold. Easily one of Scotland's most important historical sites, the castle withstood at least eight sieges. An icon of independence, a center of Royal celebration, and a stunning day out that merges fact and fiction where you will meet costumed characters in the castle who will welcome you into 16th-century life. Explore the Great Hall, Castle Exhibition, Tapestry Studio, decorated gardens, and more. See Wallace Monument that is a tower that stands on the summit of Abbey Craig, a hilltop, which overlooks Stirling.

Day 4: Monday, August 24 – Glencoe

Today we start our travels going through Glencoe, one of Scotland's most famous and most scenic Highland Glens. Wonderful photo opps! And you might spot a Glencoe Stag! Combine relaxing sightseeing and a touch of the mystic with the Inspiration Cruise on Loch Ness. This one-hour boat ride will take you from Clansman Harbour to Urquhart Castle. Relax on your trip and the beautiful expanse of sea and nature around you as you approach the historic Urquhart Castle, a ramshackle, fallen ruin in the Highlands. Glide across the famous lake and take in tantalizing tales of myths and history from the onboard audio guide and don't forget to look out for Nessie using the ship's sonar.

Day 6: Wednesday, August 26 –Blair Castle & Edinburgh Military Tattoo

This morning we are off to explore Blair Castle. Ensnconced in 700 years of history, Blair Castle is the ancient seat of the Dukes and Earls of Atholl and home to the Atholl Highlanders, Europe's last remaining private army. A diverse and divisive history has seen times of war, epic battles, and political unrest. A hub of Scottish baronial architecture, the 18th -century interiors include a lavish Victorian ballroom (with its 175 pairs of antlers). The castle grounds are equally magnificent, growing across nine acres and restored to the true beauty of its original Georgian design.

Tonight! An evening at the Edinburgh Military Tattoo is a spectacular celebration of music, tradition, and pageantry set against the stunning backdrop of Edinburgh Castle. Held annually in August, this world-renowned event brings together military bands, dancers, and performers from around the globe, creating an unforgettable display of culture and talent. The show features stirring bagpipe music, precision marching, and vibrant performances, all choreographed to perfection. The illuminated castle provides a dramatic setting as fireworks light up the sky, enhancing the mesmerizing atmosphere. The Tattoo showcases Scotland's rich heritage alongside international acts, creating a unique fusion of global cultures. Whether it's the haunting notes of the lone piper or the energy of the massed bands, the Edinburgh Military Tattoo is an awe-inspiring experience.
